NOTICE OF DOCKETING

On or about August 13, 2025, Complainant filed a complaint with the Department of Labor's Occupational Safety and Health Administration ("OSHA") alleging Respondent violated the employee protection provisions of the Taxpayer First Act of 2019 ("TFA"), 26 U.S.C. § 7623(d), and the implementing regulations at 29 C.F.R. § 1989.

OSHA issued a determination letter dated September 9, 2025, dismissing the complaint as untimely. Complainant, representing himself, has appealed the dismissal and the Office of Administrative Law Judges ("OALJ") docketed the above referenced case on September 12, 2025.¹

It is not yet assigned to a presiding administrative law judge ("ALJ"). A Notice of Hearing and Prehearing Order will be sent to the parties once the matter is assigned to an ALJ. Unless an exemption applies, the parties are required to make initial disclosures within 21 days of the date of this notice without awaiting a discovery request or discovery order.
